What?

Give out pamphlets, sell books, and discuss meeting schedules for those wanting to try Al-Anon out. Setup and breakdown the table, and store literature. (You will have all information prior to serving.)

The warmth of knowing you are changing the lives of those who are struggling with alcoholism and addiction, at a very vulnerable time in their lives. The fellowship of serving with another Al-Anon member, possibly someone you don’t know beforehand.
